From Rte. 495

Take Exit 31 at Littleton Common onto Rte. 119 West through Groton Center. Approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile on the Right will be the entrance to Deluxe Pinpoint (Formerly N.E.B.S.)

From Rte. 111

Go to Rte 119 East Approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile on the Left will be the entrance for Deluxe Pinpoint (formerly N.E.B.S.)

We will be using the DELUXE PINPOINT parking lot and we ask that you clean your parking area of all manure and hay before you leave.

Competitors are reminded that happy landowners are a vital necessity to any hunt and pace event, because of this we ask that you jump only the designated fences, jumping others will incur elimination. Thank you for your cooperation.
